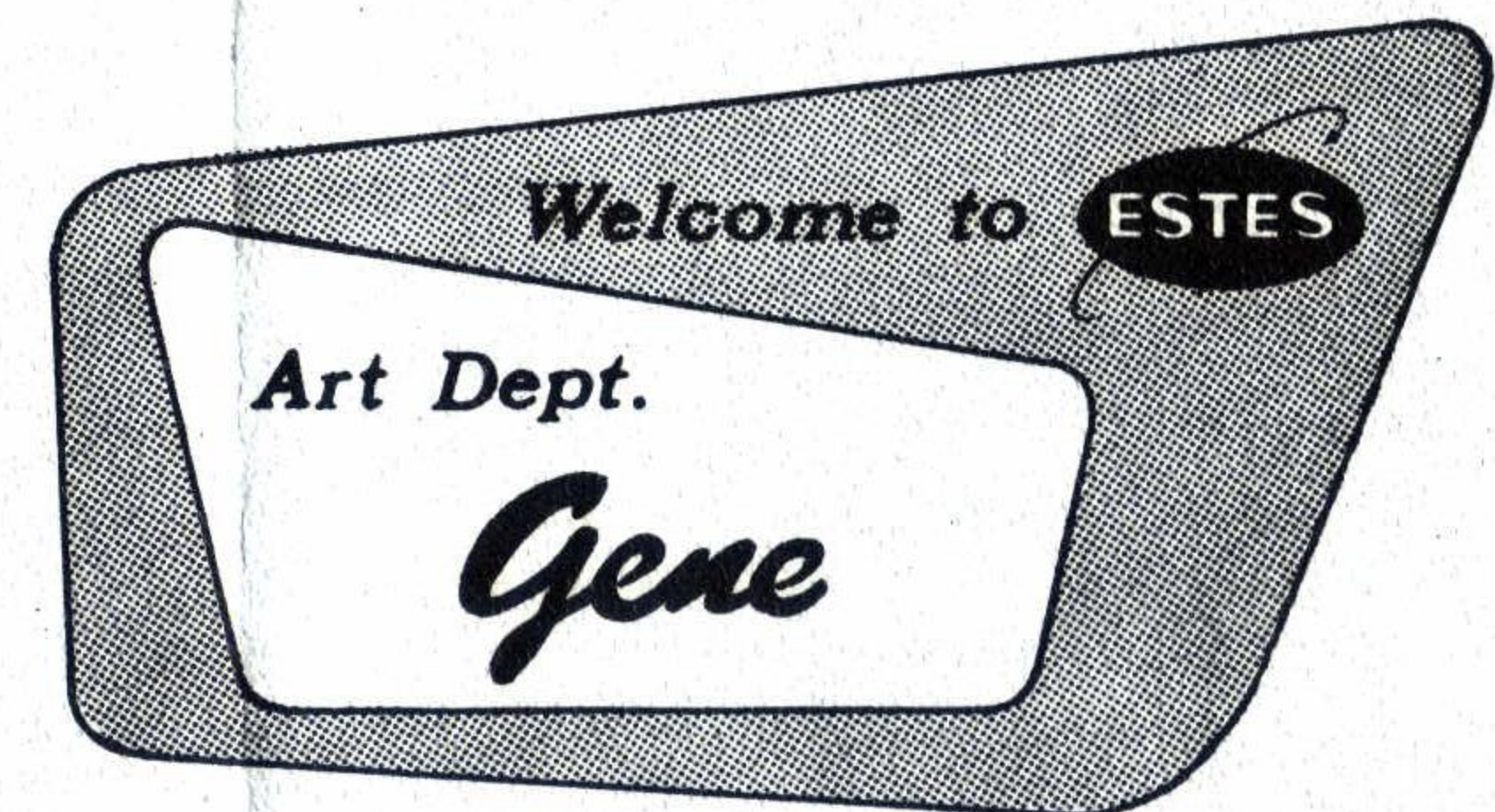
# NOTICE
